**Camp Format:** Training will take place at Lawrence Soccer Complex on the northeast side of Indianapolis. Each camp day will consist of two 70 minute training sessions with a 10 minute break in between. Activities will be a balance between technical drills and competitive games which put the skills to use. Additional assistant coaches will be used as needed to maintain a healthy player to coach ratio.

**Camp Director:** Miles Glynn is the founder and director of Indiana Goalkeeper Academy. Coach Glynn played at Mount St. Clare College (now Ashford University) in Iowa and now resides in Indianapolis, IN. In addition to directing IGA, Coach Glynn has served in the following roles: Indiana ODP Head Goalkeeper Coach, Butler University Men's Goalkeeper Coach (NCAA Division 1), IUPUI Women's Goalkeeper Coach (NCAA Division 1), Anderson University Men's & Women's Assistant Coach, ODP Region II Girls Goalkeeping Staff Coach, Director of Goalkeeping: FC Pride Soccer Club, Noblesville United Soccer Club, and Indianapolis Premier Soccer Club, Indiana Youth Soccer Youth Module Coaching Education Instructor. Coach Glynn holds the USSF National C License, USSF National Goalkeeping License, USSF National Youth License, NSCAA Goalkeeping Level II Diploma, and is Red Cross CPR Certified.
